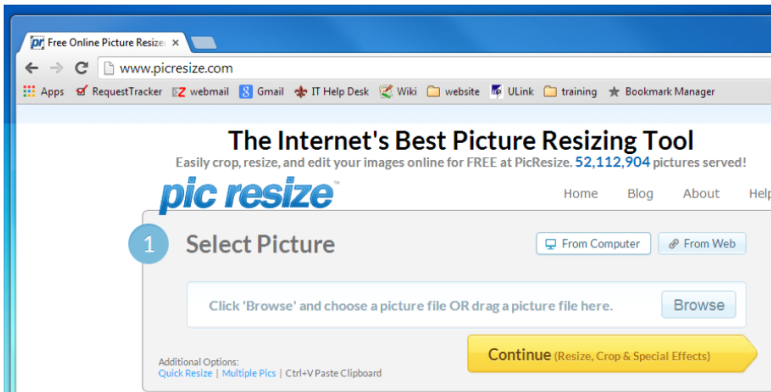


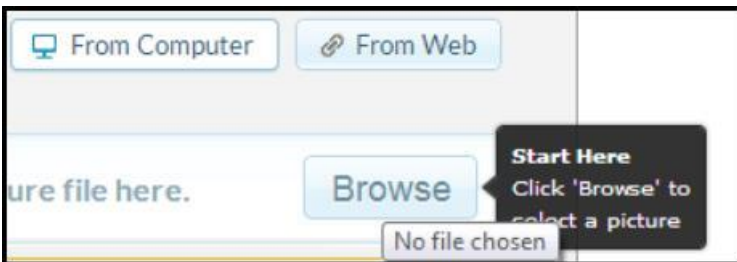
Picresize.com

Open a web browser and go to www.picresize.com

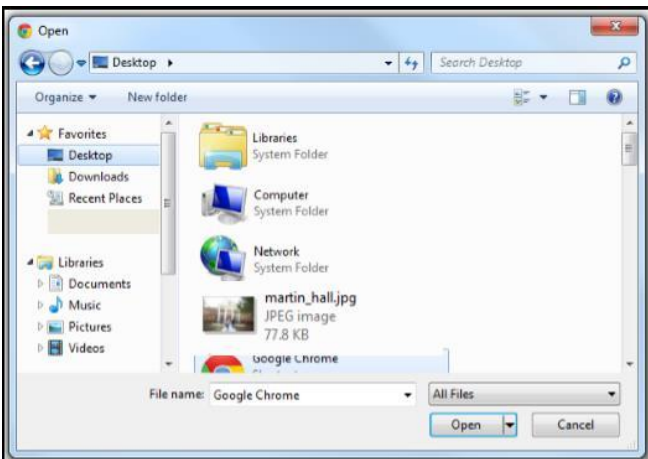


Click **Browse** button on the webpage

(if the browse button is not visible, the "From Web" option may have been chosen. Click on From Computer to enable the Browse button)

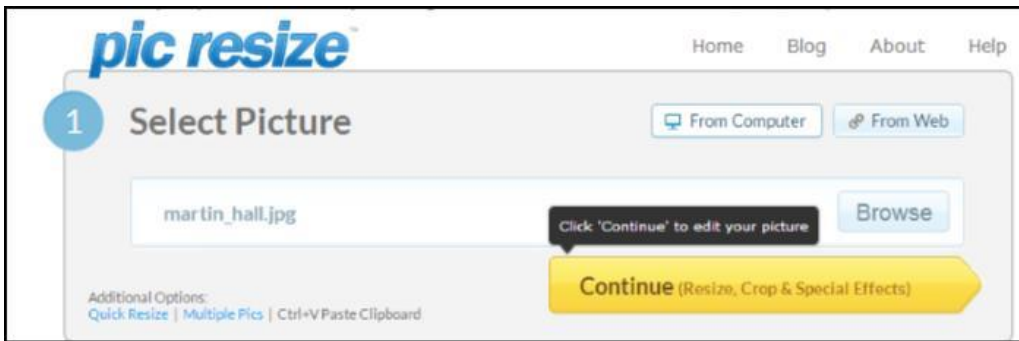


Navigate to the picture file and click on the icon, then click **Open**.

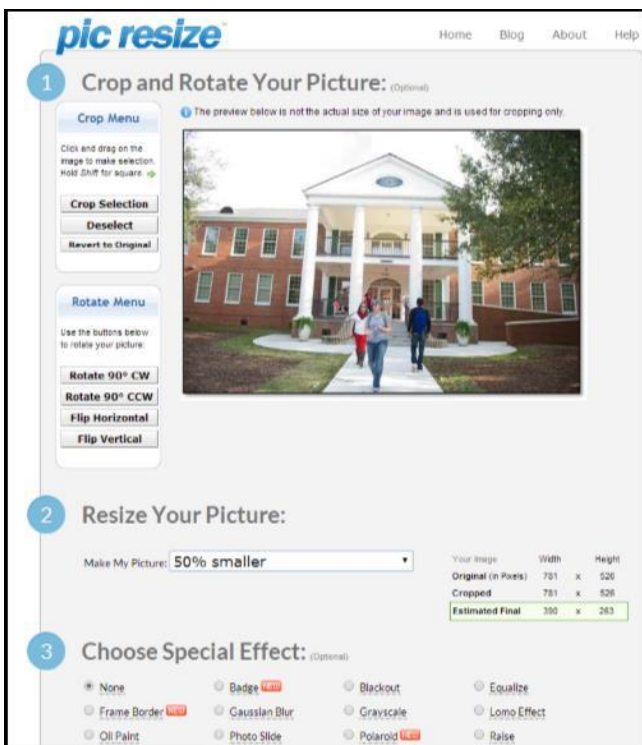


Your picture file will appear in the Pic Resize window under **Select Picture**.

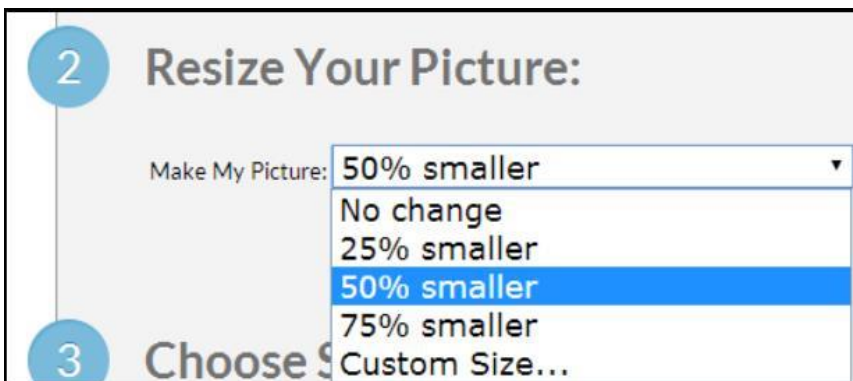
Click **Continue**.



Scroll down to #2 **Resize Your Picture**.



Click the dropdown list next to **Make My Picture:** and choose **Custom Size**.



Enter the desired **pixel width** (maximum 600). The width will automatically adjust to keep the image in proportion.

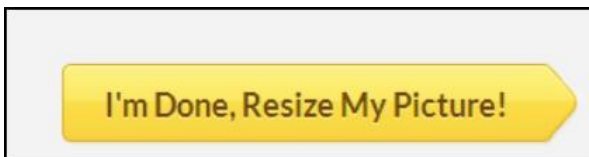

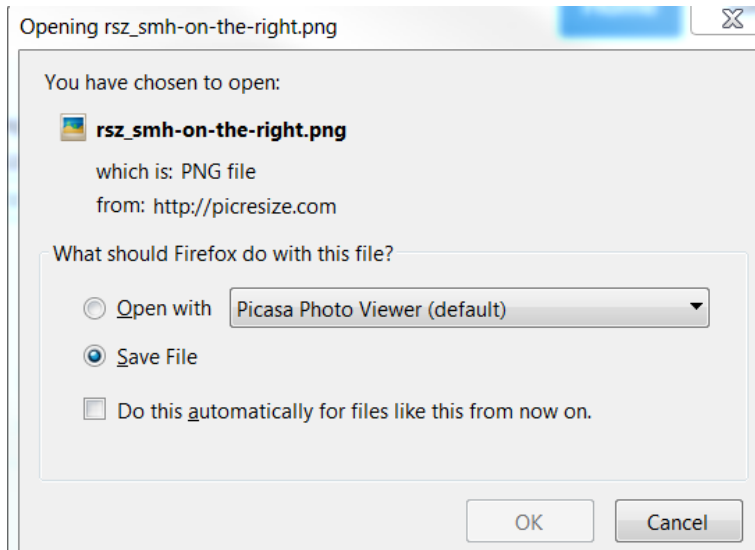

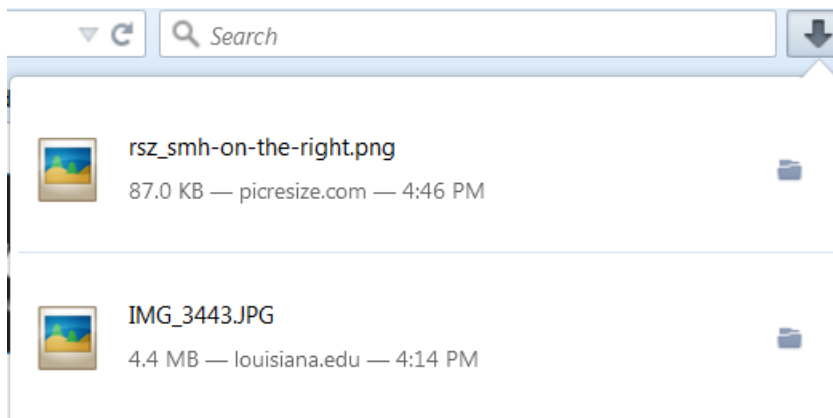
Click **Save File** and then click **OK**.



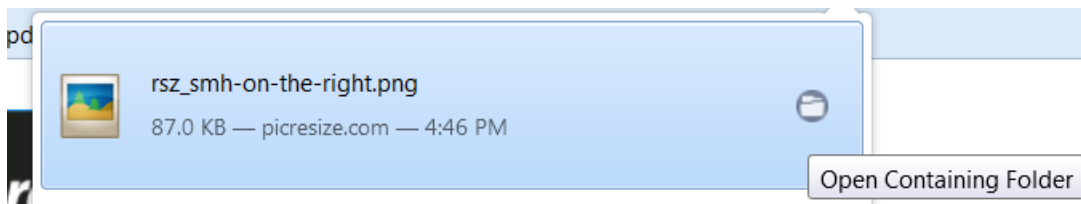
Your new image file will have **rsz_** added to the original file name.
